Arranged for 3-string fretted cigar box guitar tuned to Open G GDG.

This song has become the de facto standard for plaintive American tunes. It made quite a few appearances in Ken Burns' "Civil War" documentary, and has had countless other airings. Now you can master it on your 3-string CBG! We have tabbed it in the key of "C" instead of the more traditional "D" to make it easier to play.
