


## **Oh Christmas Tree (O Tannenbaum)**

## Arranged for 3-string fretted cigar box guitar tuned to Open G GDG.

Here's a Christmas song that comes to us from Germany, where it is known as O Tannenbaum. It was not not originally written to be a song about Christmas trees, but rather about evergreens in general as a symbol of unchanging faithfulness. But over the years it has become one of the best known songs about the Christmas holiday, and it is nice and easy to play on the three-string cigar box guitar. We present both the basic melody and a more advanced version with chord strumming to fill out the sound.


## Version 1 - Basic Melody
